Special Agent Melissa R. Stormer is assigned to the Air Force Office of Special Investigations (AFOSI) 2nd Field Investigations Squadron (FIS) Regional Polygraph Office, Andrews AFB, MD. She is currently a doctoral student at the Chicago School of Professional Psychology in Washington, D.C., where she is pursuing a doctorate in Clinical Psychology.

SA Stormer was born in Milwaukee, WI, and attended high school at Mondovi Public High School in Mondovi, WI. She graduated from the American Intercontinental University with a B.S. in Criminal Justice; Argosy University Northern VA with a M.A. in Forensic Psychology; and the American School of Professional Psychology at Argosy University Northern Virginia with a M.A. in Clinical Psychology.

SA Stormer enlisted in the Air Force on February 24th, 1999, as a Dental Technician. She was selected for duty as an AFOSI Special Agent in 2003. SA Stormer separated from active duty and returned to AFOSI as a civilian agent in 2008. Upon joining AFOSI, SA Stormer was assigned to Travis AFB, CA and worked both general crimes and counterintelligence. From August 2005 to January 2006, she was deployed to Kuwait in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, where she worked as a field agent. SA Stormer became a polygraph examiner in 2006 and was selected as the Regional Polygraph Office Branch Chief for AFOSI 1 FIS in 2010. SA Stormer was selected for an assignment to the HQ AFOSI Polygraph Program Management Office in 2012, where she worked for the AFOSI Polygraph Program Manager until she was selected as the Regional Polygraph Office Branch Chief for AFOSI 2 FIS in 2015. In 2016, she was selected for a doctoral program in Clinical Psychology. She has completed four deployments as a polygraph examiner in Iraq and Afghanistan. Her most recent deployment was to Kabul, Afghanistan from August 2013 to March 2014 as the theater Credibility Assessment Program Manager.

Currently, SA Stormer conducts and supervises criminal, counterintelligence, and counterintelligence screening polygraph examinations supporting military and federal organizations throughout the Eastern United States.
